<u>Senior privilege</u> of 1st Choice parking=> Spots will be sold to seniors only on Friday & Monday. Also, (because of a safety concern) will be open to Governor's School students on Monday.

Spots will become open to <u>all others</u> beginning the following Tuesday (August 15, 2017).

Students must show Driver's License when purchasing parking pass.

<u>Information regarding Parking on MSHS Campus</u>

It is the responsibility of the administration of MSHS to ensure a safe overall environment for students, faculty, and staff. To this end, all vehicles parked on school grounds must be registered and a current parking sticker must be visible at all times.

This is necessary to ensure the safety of your student(s). Registering vehicles makes it easier to identify trespassers (who may present a security risk) and to identify the owner of the car in case of an emergency.

Please remember that <u>parking on campus is a privilege</u>, not a right. The following are guidelines that all drivers are required to follow:

- 1) Poor attendance, tardiness to school, or other disciplinary infractions may result in loss of driving privileges.
- 2) Students must not owe money on their cafeteria account or must develop a payment plan to eliminate debt. Failure to not clear the debt may result in loss of parking privileges.
- 3) The school is not responsible for the vehicle or its contents.
- 4) The parking tag must be clearly displayed when the vehicle is parked on campus. When driving a second vehicle, students are to switch the tag to the alternate vehicle.
- 5) The vehicle must be parked in the assigned spot. Parking elsewhere is cause for revocation of driving privileges.
- 6) Vehicles are *subject to search*. The search of vehicles on campus is a part of the continuing effort on the part of school officials to maintain a campus free from weapons, alcohol, drugs, and other items which may pose a danger or risk to students and faculty. Any student who exercises the privilege of parking on school grounds shall be considered to have given *implied consent* to a search of such automobile at any time a search is requested by the school administration.
- Parking lot speed shall not exceed 15 mph. Reckless and/or irresponsible operation is cause for revocation of parking privileges.
- 8) All unregistered vehicles parked on campus may be towed at owner's expense.

The registration fee for the year is \$10.00. This is a small price to pay to help us ensure the safety of our students. Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter.
